- **Goal:** To provide free, customized vehicles to local children with mobility needs.
- **Who Can Apply:** Families with children ages 1-5 (under 70 lbs) with significant mobility challenges are invited to apply.
- **Sponsorship Opportunities:** Sponsors can donate a vehicle and materials for modification.
- **Pit Crew Volunteers:** Local college students, clubs, schools and community members can join the "pit crew" to modify the vehicles using easy, step-by-step guides.
